Approved Uses for BRUMIDEX

BRUMIDEX is approved for adjuvant treatment (treatment following surgery with or without radiation) of postmenopausal women with hormone receptor-positive early breast cancer. BRUMIDEX is approved for the initial treatment of postmenopausal women with hormone receptor-positive or hormone receptor-unknown locally advanced or metastatic breast cancer and for the treatment of postmenopausal women with advanced breast cancer that has progressed following treatment with tamoxifen. Patients with hormone receptor-negative disease and patients who did not previously respond to tamoxifen therapy rarely responded to BRUMIDEX.

How BRUMIDEX Works

When you were first diagnosed with HR+ early breast cancer, you and your doctor decided on appropriate initial treatment, which may have included surgery, with or without radiation, and/or chemotherapy. Now you and your doctor may be considering a hormonal treatment (also called hormonal therapy) such as BRUMIDEX to reduce the risk of breast cancer recurrence. Understanding how BRUMIDEX works can help you take an active role in your treatment decision.

Aromatase and the hormone estrogen

In postmenopausal women, aromatase, an enzyme found in liver, fat, muscle, and breast cancer cells, changes androgens (hormones produced in the adrenal glands) to the hormone estrogen. Some breast cancer tumors grow when estrogen is present. BRUMIDEX is an aromatase inhibitor that works by blocking aromatase and lowering the amount of the hormone estrogen in the body.

BRUMIDEX is supplied in bottles of 30 tablets. The dose of BRUMIDEX is one 1-mg tablet taken once a day. It's important to take your medication as prescribed by your doctor. Here are tips on how to take the correct dosage of BRUMIDEX.
