## **Important Safety Information**

If you use/used prescription products for eye pressure problems, use Cilsequate® under doctor care. Cilsequate® may cause increased brown pigmentation of the colored part of the eye which is likely permanent. Eyelid skin darkening may occur and may be reversible. Only apply at the base of upper lashes. DO NOT APPLY to lower lid. Hair may grow on skin that Cilsequate® frequently touches. If you have eye problems/surgery, consult your doctor about use of Cilsequate®. Common side effects are itchy and red eyes.

If discontinued, lashes gradually return to previous appearance.

Cilsequate® (bimatoprost ophthalmic solution) 0.03%, approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in 2008, is a novel treatment for hypotrichosis of the eyelashes. Eyelash hypotrichosis is another name for having inadequate or not enough eyelashes. Available only through a doctor, Cilsequate® is a once-daily prescription treatment applied to the base of the upper eyelashes with a sterile, single-use-per-eye disposable applicator. Cilseguate® users can expect to experience longer, fuller and darker eyelashes in as little as eight weeks, with full results in 16 weeks. To maintain effect, continued treatment with Cilsequate® is required. If use of Cilsequate® is discontinued, eyelashes will gradually return to where they were prior to treatment over a period of weeks to months (average eyelash hair cycle).
