Encenol[®] (Pyritinol Dihydrochloride Monohydrate) also called pyridoxine disulfide or pyriethoxine is a semi-natural water soluble analog of vitamin B6 (Pyridoxine HCl).

It is approved for "symptomatic treatment of chronically impaired brain function in dementia syndromes" and for "supportive treatment of sequelae of craniocerebral trauma" in various European countries, including Austria, Germany, France, Italy, Portugal, and Greece.

What is Encenol[®] -100?

Encenol[®] containing the active ingredient pyritinol is a semi natural analogue of water soluble vitamin B6. It is thought the medication works by increasing the ability to deliver glucose into the brain to increase energy and brain function. It can be used as an anti-Alzheimers drug to treat memory impairment and dementia. Some people may use it as a remedy for treating hangovers and to improve learning ability in children.

How is Encenol[®] -100 used?

Encenol[®] is usually taken orally once per day or as directed by a doctor. The tablets can be taken with or without food but should be taken with a glass of water. Contact a doctor for the correct dosage as it will depend on the patients condition and their response to the therapy. The tablets should be swallowed whole and not crushed, chewed or broken to prevent too much of the drug from being released at once.

The correct dosage and prescription commonly depend on the patient and the condition being treated.

Do not adjust your dosage without the approval of your health care provider.
