Prothiaden M is presented as film-coated tablets, containing:

Prothiaden 75 - Dosulepin Hydrochloride I.P.-75mg

Methylcobalamin-1500mcg

Excipients - q.s

Xraden®-M Dosulepin Hydrochloride 75mg / Methylcobalamin-1500mcg belongs to the Tricyclic group of antidepressants, TCAs. Side-effects

The side-effects of Xraden®-M include dry mouth, drowsiness, sweating, blurred vision and constipation, although most of these should diminish over time. You may experience some nausea and dizziness when you first start taking it, however these usually dissappear in a week or two.

A lowered sex drive is also a common side effect of this, as with most antidepressants. If you experience any unusual symptoms or are concerned about side effects in anyway, it is important that you discuss this with your doctor or consult a pharmacist for advice. Usually these will not be anything to worry about, but best to be sure.
