Allopurinol Tablets USP

Zyloprid[®] (Allopurinol Tablets USP) is used to treat gout or kidney stones, and to decrease levels of uric acid in certain cancer patients.

Zyloprid[®] (Allopurinol Tablets USP), 100 mg and 300 mg is a drug used primarily to treat hyperuricemia (excess uric acid in blood plasma) and its complications, including chronic gout. It is a xanthine oxidase inhibitor which is administered orally.

Indications and Usage for Zyloprid[®] (Allopurinol Tablets USP) :

THIS IS NOT AN INNOCUOUS DRUG. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR THE TREATMENT OF ASYMPTOMATIC HYPERURICEMIA.

Zyloprid[®] (Allopurinol Tablets USP) reduces serum and urinary uric acid concentrations. Its use should be individualized for each patient and requires an understanding of its mode of action and pharmacokinetics (see CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY, CONTRAINDICATIONS, WARNINGS and PRECAUTIONS).

Zyloprid[®] (Allopurinol Tablets USP) is indicated in:

the management of patients with signs and symptoms of primary or secondary gout (acute attacks, tophi, joint destruction, uric acid lithiasis, and/or nephropathy).
